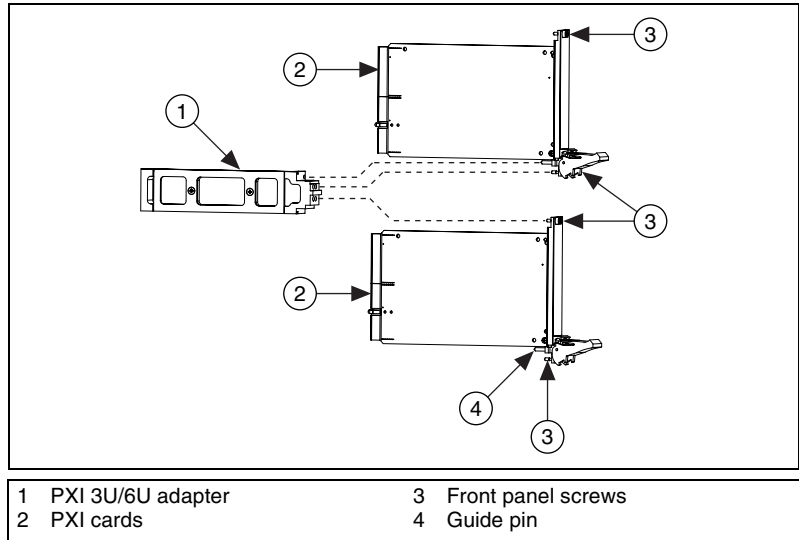
## INSTALLATION GUIDE

# NI PXI 3U/6U Adapter Kit



**Note** Use this kit in conjunction with the NI PXI-1056 chassis.

To install the NI 3U/6U adapter, complete the following steps.



**Figure 1.** NI PXI 3U/6U Adapter Installation

1. Ensure that the screws on the NI PXI 3U/6U adapter are not tightened. If the screws are tight, loosen one turn.
2. Insert the guide pin from the top card into the adapter as shown and tighten the front panel screw.
3. Insert the bottom card into the guide rail on the adapter and tighten the front panel screw.
4. Make sure each card is fully seated in its respective groove on the adapter and tighten the two screws on the adapter.



**Note** It is important that both cards are completely seated in the adapter. If the cards are not properly aligned, pins on the backplane may be bent when the assembly is inserted into the chassis.
