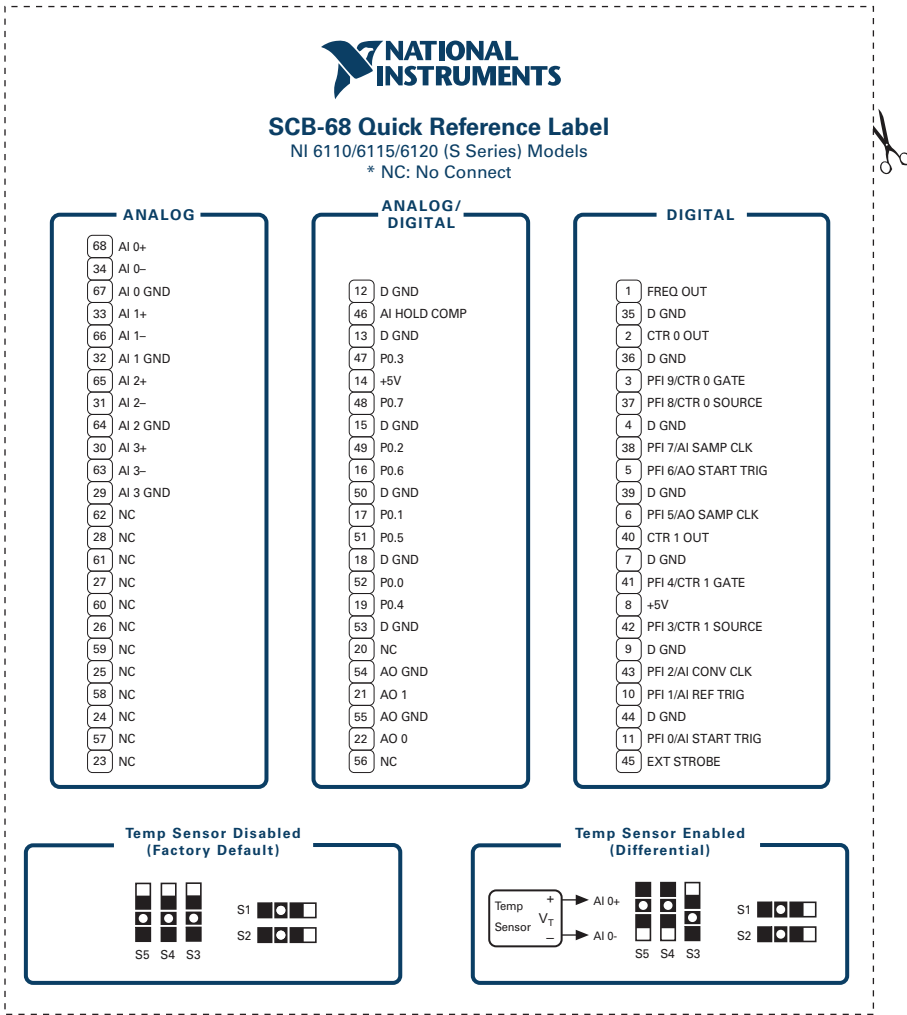

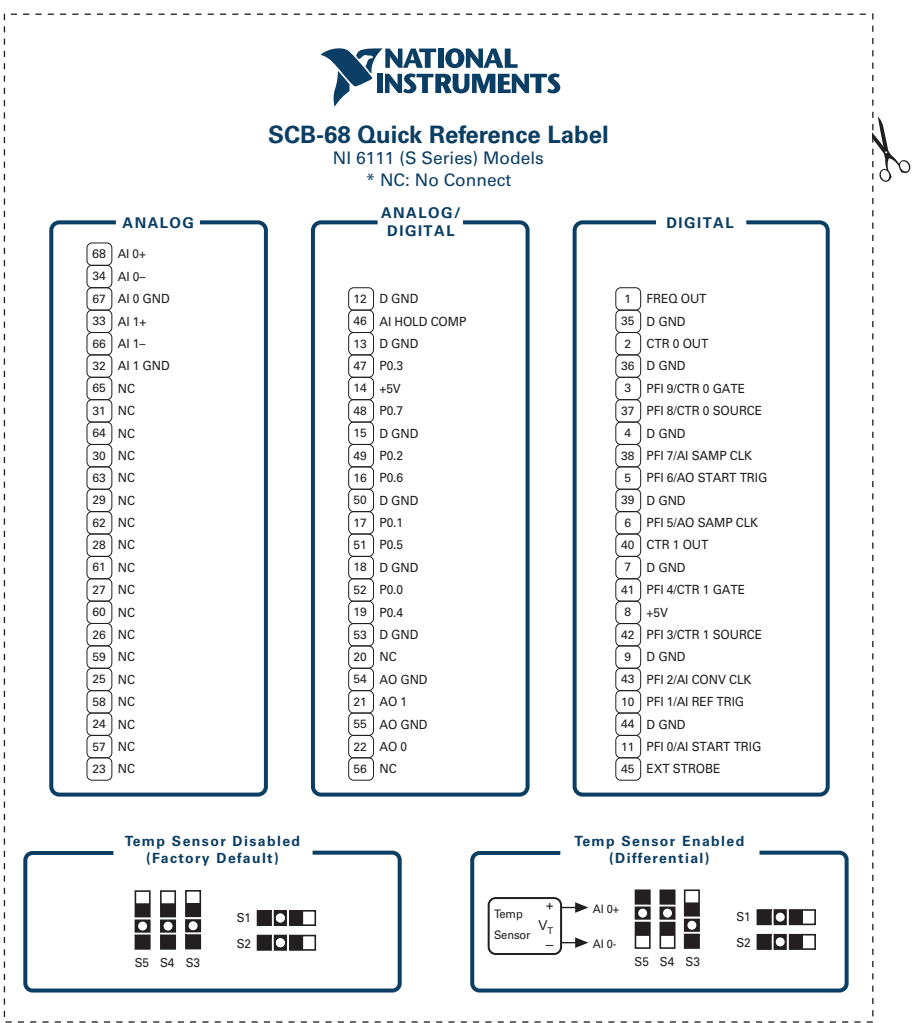

Figure 1. NI 6110/6115/6120



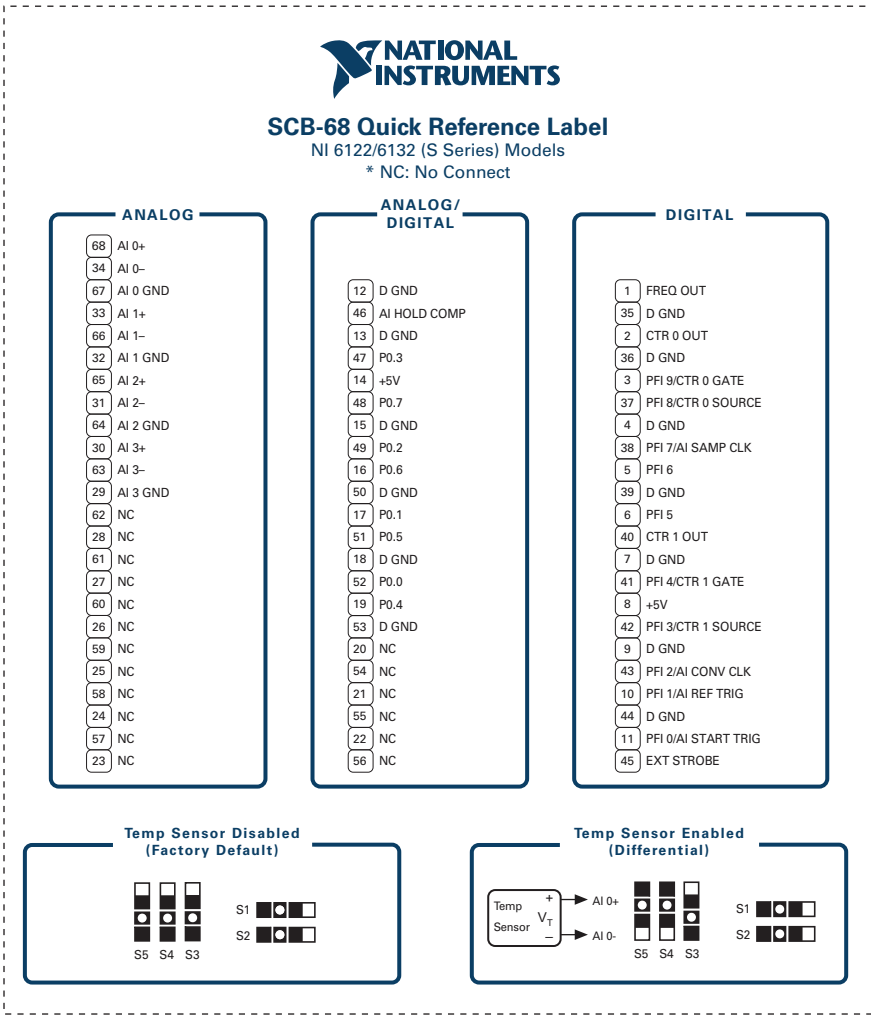

Figure 2. NI 6111



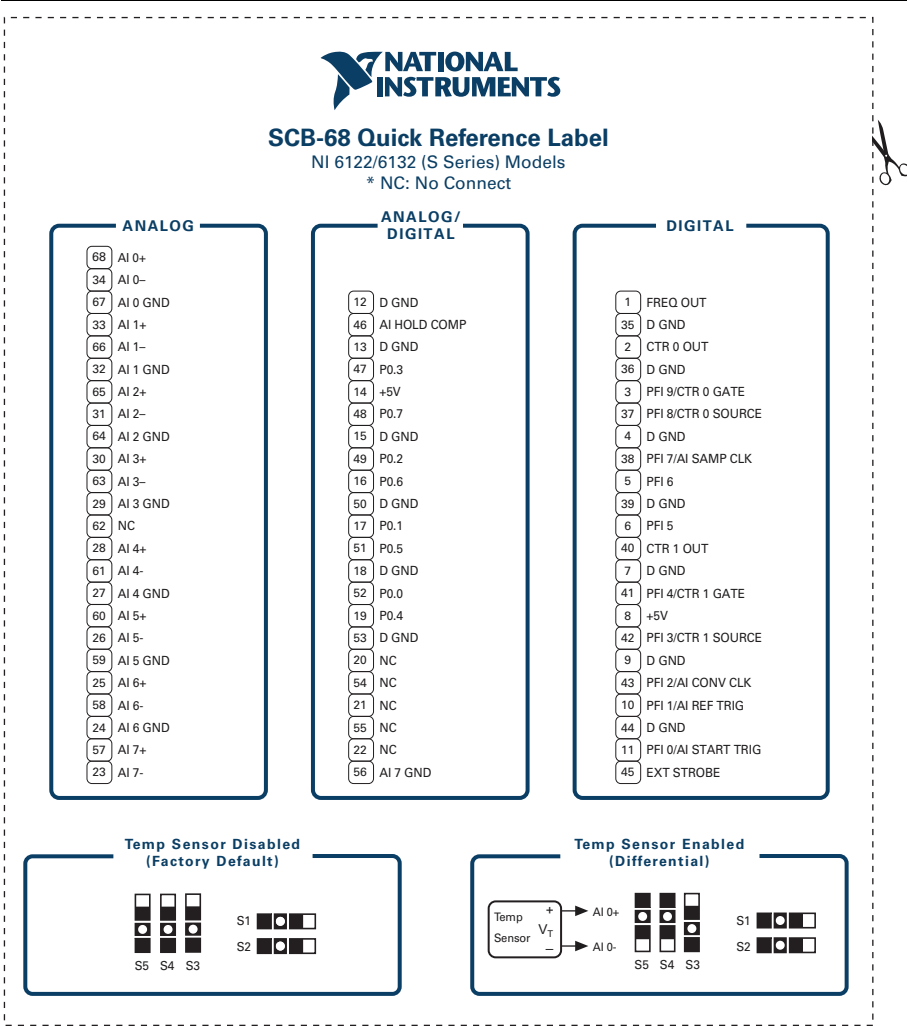

Figure 3. NI 6122/6132



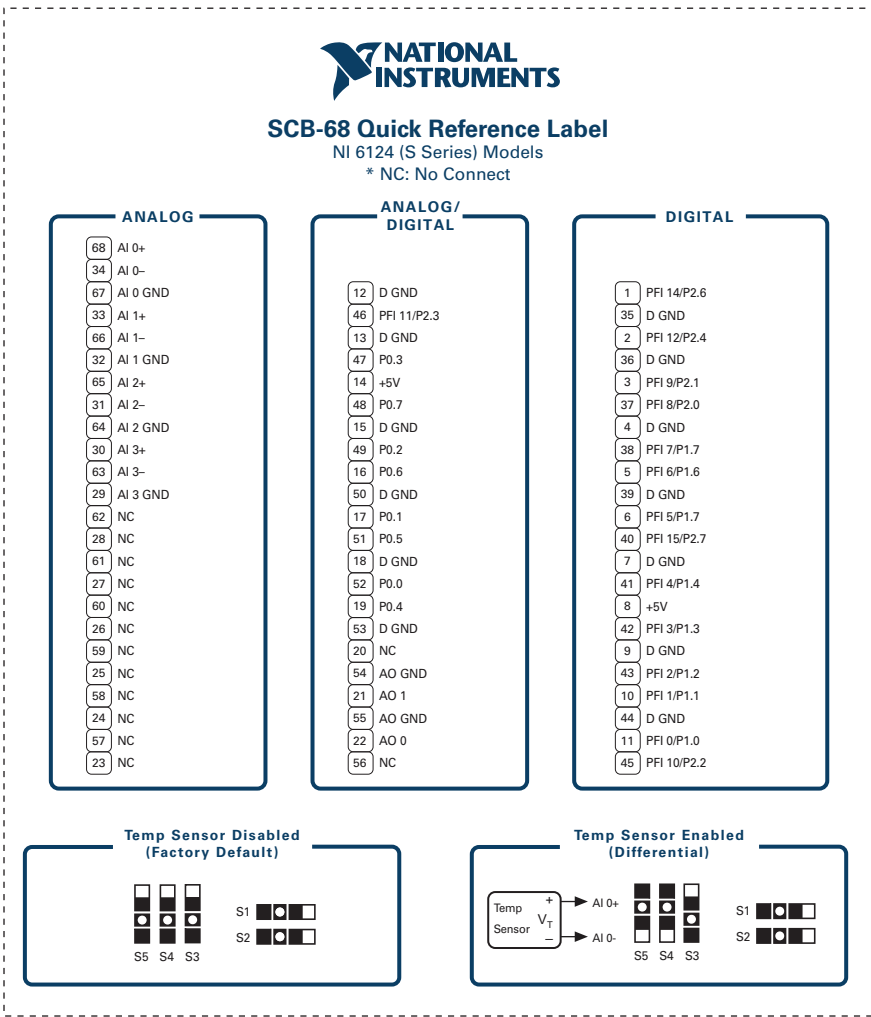
