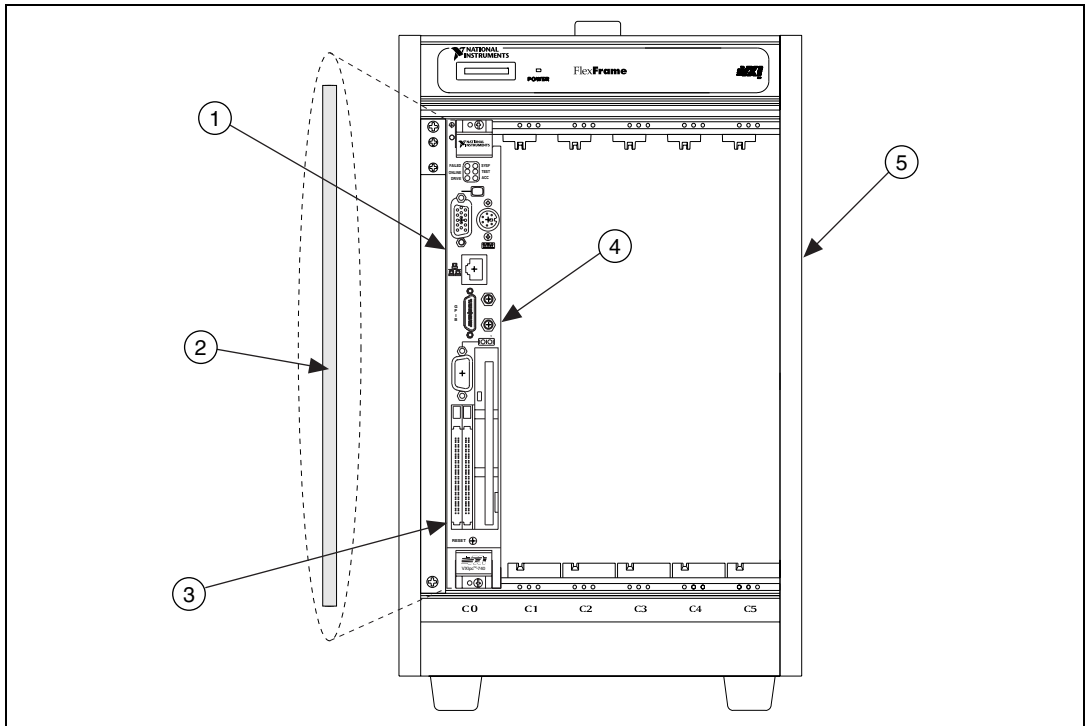

EMI REDUCTION FOR VXI 1200 FLEXFRAME™

To reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) emanating from your VXI-1394, VXI-1394/G, or VXIpc-740 series controller in your VXI 1200 FlexFrame, install the soft-shield gasket, included in your kit, as shown below.

1. Partially eject controller. Pull away from FlexFrame to create a gap.
2. Insert gasket in gap between FlexFrame and controller.
3. Close injector handles on controller to reduce gap with gasket in place.

Note It may be necessary to trim gasket length to fit between FlexFrame and controller.
